Urgent Eye Care includes any patient who have any of the following symptoms:

- Sudden Onset of Light Flashes or Floaters
- Sudden Changes in Vision
- Sudden Loss of Vision
- Eye Injury
- Eye Infection
- Foreign Body in the Eye
- Red Eye with Discharge
- Patients with a strong prescription, who broke their glasses or ran out of contacts and cannot function without them

There are many other possibilities that may be considered urgent. When in doubt, please call us our clinic or email us immediately to have your concerns addressed.

We are taking additional precautionary measures to ensure your safety upon entering our clinic. If you are experiencing a dry cough, fever, or fatigue/extreme tiredness, have any cold symptoms, or have travelled or been in contact with individuals who have travelled outside of Canada, we ask that you stay at home and go to www.alberta.ca for further instructions.

We will monitor the situation daily and continue to reassess and adapt our processes to adhere to the latest updates and authority guidelines.
